



PLAYOFF POOL

RULES

The objective of **2007 NHL Playoff Pool** is to accumulate the most number of Points based upon the Playoff Pool Scoring System (see Scoring System below). Officepools.com stats website will be utilized with all participants receiving a Pool ID and Password for site access.

TEAM ROSTER:

Pick 2 Left Wing, 2 Right Wing, 2 Centers, 3 Defencemen and 1 Goaltending "Team" (10 players) from **both** NHL's Eastern and Western Conference for a total of 20 selections. A Player list and Roster form will be provided with player information including player position. No Roster changes or substitution occur once the playoffs begin.

SCORING SYSTEM:

Key

G – Goal A – Assist GWG – Game Winning Goal OTG – Overtime Goal
 W – Win SO – Shutout L – Loss SW – Series Win

Position	G	A	GWG*	OTG*
All Skaters	1	1	1	2

*Bonus Point(s)

Scoring Example: If skater has these stats – 7 Goals, 5 Assists, 2 GWG and 1 OTG his points would be 16 (7+5+2+2=16).

Position	W	L	SO*	SW*
Goaltending Team	2	-1	2	2

Scoring Example: If Goaltending Team has these stats – 7 Wins, 5 Losses, 1 Shutout and 1 Series Win the points would be 13 (14-5+2+2=13).

FEES, WINNER & PRIZE:

Fee is \$20 U.S (approx 23 Canadian). Entrant with most points upon completion of 2007 NHL Stanley Cup Playoffs using scoring system above is winner. Entire prize pool goes to winner. Note: Prize pool amount = Pool entry fees minus fees for website and payment service. Fees paid in \$U.S and converted to CDN if necessary. Entry fee and roster form **MUST** be received by 6PM EST on the first night of the playoffs (Tentative Wednesday April 11).

Tie Breaker:

1. Most points using only Goals, Assists + Goaltending Team Points (excludes GWG +OTG)
2. Most Points using only Goals and Assists (excludes GWG, OTG, and Goaltender Points)
3. Most Goals only
4. Game Winning Goals
5. Overtime Goals
6. Prize divided equally among winners.
